A true jewel of style for the bathroom, the new Metropolitan vanity unit pays tribute to the great early 20th century European and American design. Its unmistakably retro lines and exquisite materials reinterpret the great design tradition of the 1920s and 1930s in a completely new way, perfect for contemporary living.



A jewel of style

Wood, marble, brass: in Metropolitan the quality of the most exquisite raw materials and the precision of the craftsmanship are at one with the beauty that shapes them.

The dual volume of the cabinet body, outlined by the polished lacquered wood frames, is marked by the continuous series of brass slats, the true stylistic signature of the new creation of the Devon&Devon Style Office.

The marble top is available in Bianco Carrara, Granito Nero Assoluto, Calacatta Borghini or Nero Marquina.

In addition to brass (customisable in various finishes), the slats are also available in lacquered wood.

Inspiration

The solid geometry, the stepped profile and the tight succession of slats enveloping the body of Metropolitan are explicit references to large and small Art Deco masterpieces designed in the 1920s and 1930s in Europe and the United States.

The inspiration behind the design of this unique vanity unit spans from impressive masterpieces of industrial and residential architecture (such as the Crevoladossola hydroelectric power station by Pietro Portaluppi - 1923 - with its broad facade punctuated by diamond-shaped bossage stonework and the audacious Villa Cavrois by Robert Mallet-Stevens - 1932 - with its plastic and linear volumes characterised by precise symmetries) to the highly sought-after design of small objects with elegantly moulded and grooved surfaces (such as the Skyscraper Radio by Harold Van Doren - 1936 -, the 1930s lighters by S.T. Dupont and the partition screen designed by Alvar Aalto in the 1940s).



Metropolitan Ceramic

The Metropolitan vanity unit is also available in the Metropolitan Ceramic version, which - retaining the refined design of the original - replaces the marble top with a white ceramic one and the brass slats with wooden ones, available in Deep Black, Pure White, Cream or Warm Grey.
